- All times must be GPS.
- All race instructions will be given at the briefing.
- Start signals will be 10 minutes and 5 minutes.
- Start is then self-policing, unless committee boat present. The OD will sound a horn at start over VHF.
- Radio silence from 10 minutes to start.
- Engines off by 5 minutes.
- Any infringements must be declared and penalties taken.
- ISFA Racing Rules of Sailing apply.
- WSBA race declaration and handicap required.
- LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.
- SKIPPERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR OWN BOAT SAFTEY

#### **Racing Declaration**

- All boat owners or persons in charge must complete this before competing in any competition organised by this club.
- The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance is the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and her crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the competition. Neither these instructions nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and her management.
- The organisers, club, club officers and members shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the competition. Moreover, the owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat and her crew for the competition.
