### Racing Declaration

- All boat owners or persons in charge must complete this before competing in any competition organised by this club.
- The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance is the sole responsibility of the owner/person in charge who must ensure that the boat and her crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the competition. Neither these instructions nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/person in charge for the crew, the boat and her management.
- The organisers, club, club officers and members shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the competition. Moreover, the owner/person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat and her crew for the competition.
